Donald L. Kerstner, age 82, of Wausau died on Wednesday, January 20, 2016 at Aspirus Wausau Hospital.

Donald was born on March 10, 1933 in Clintonville, Wisconsin to the late Erick and Mildred (Olmsted) Kerstner. He served his country honorably in the US Navy, serving in the Korean War. Donald married Doris Strelow in Bowler in 1954.

In his working years Donald's expertise was in the realm of windows both as draftsman and in sales. He was a fine woodworking craftsman who made furniture and cabinets. He also enjoyed traveling, playing cards, and golf.

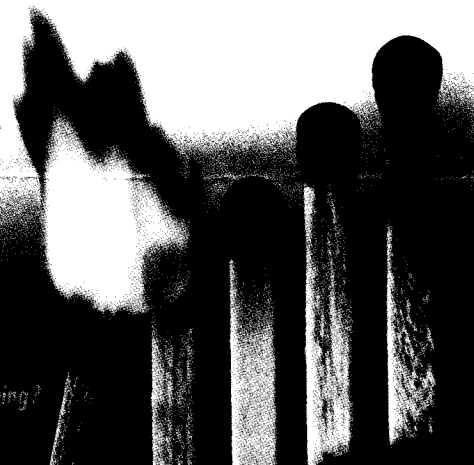
