



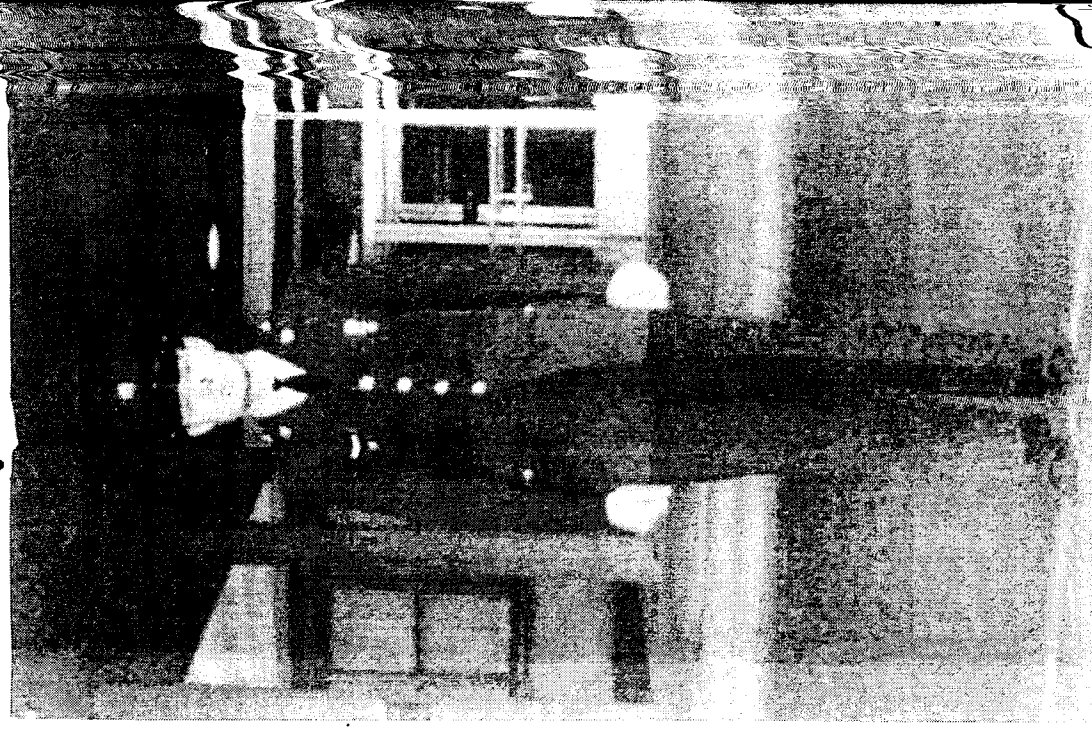
Cards made for the Honor Flight Veterans

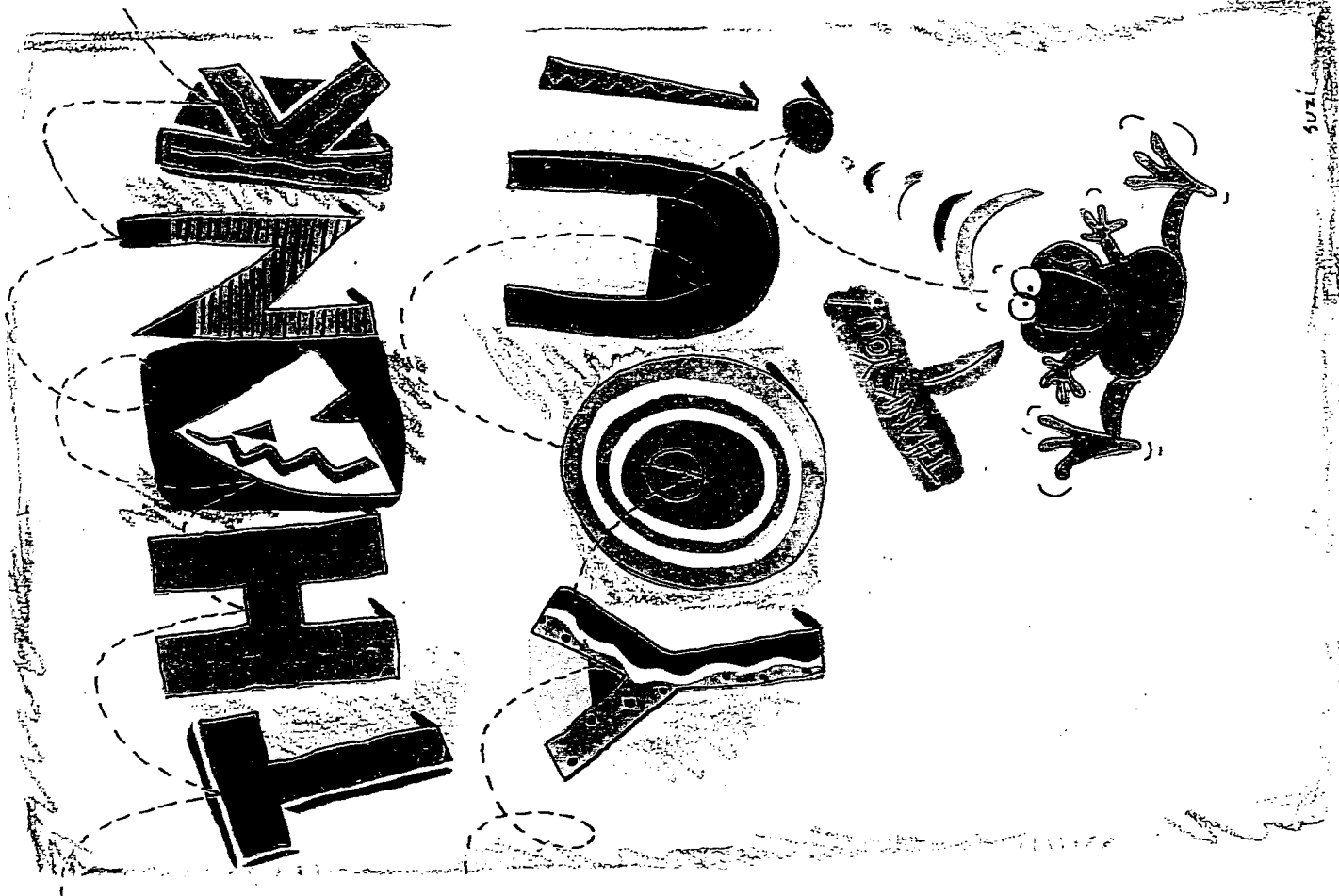

see our memorial wall & that was

very hard for me. I had friends on it.

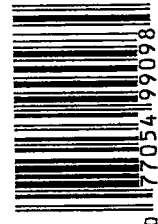
