

Facts You Should Know:

- ★ Approximately 800 WWII veterans die each day in the USA.
- ★ The youngest WWII veteran is over 85 years old.
- ★ Veterans of WWII waited over 60 years for their memorial. Most have been unable to see it ... until now.
- ★ We provide trained volunteer “guardians” to accompany the veterans on the aircraft and while visiting their memorials. Guardians pay their own way by making a \$500 donation.
- ★ Spouses are not allowed to serve as guardians. Guardians must be between the ages of 18-69.
- ★ Never Forgotten Honor Flight is a 100% volunteer organization.

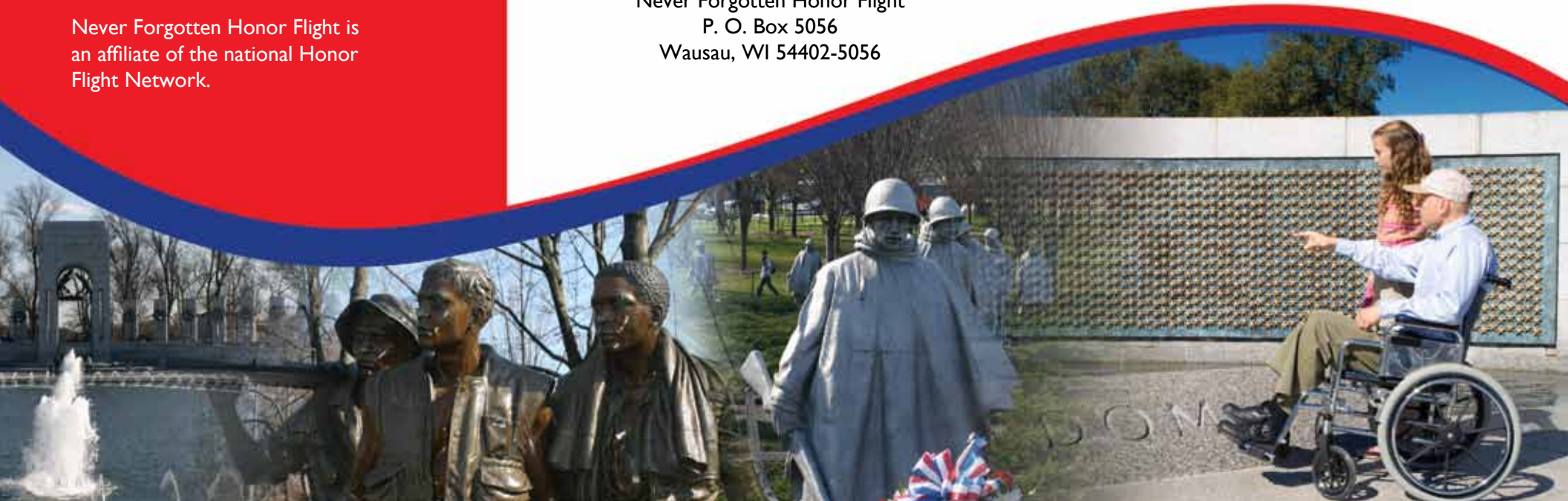

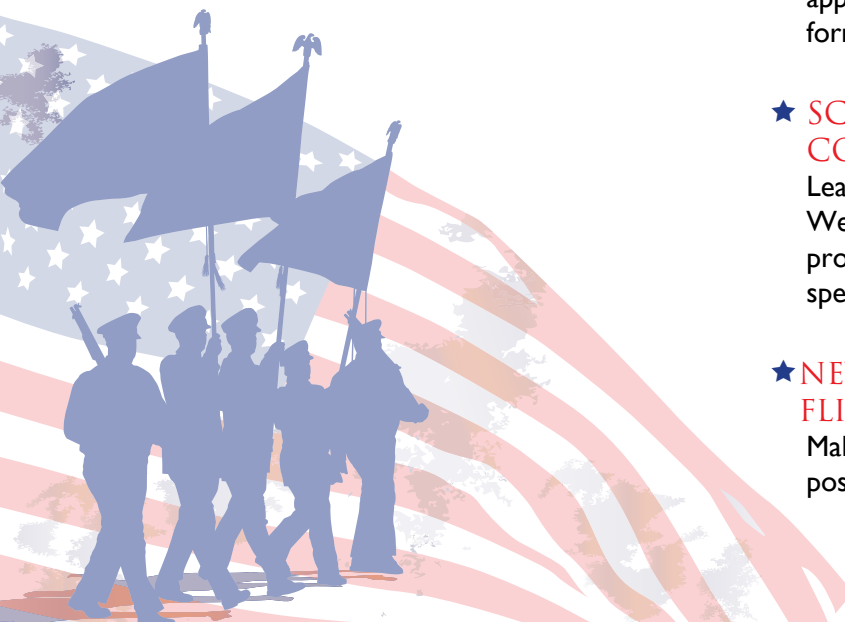


JOIN OUR MISSION TO FLY VETERANS TO WASHINGTON D.C. TO VISIT THE MEMORIALS THAT STAND IN THEIR HONOR.

Many veterans are unable to undertake a trip like this on their own. We honor them by providing this trip to visit their memorial at no cost to the veterans. The flight, deluxe tour bus service, shirts, meals and other amenities are provided FREE to the veterans. We also provide trained, volunteer “guardians” to accompany the veterans on the aircraft and at the memorials.

The Honor Flight Network has safely transported tens of thousands of veterans from all across the United States. Top priority is given to America’s most senior veterans — survivors of WWII — and to any veterans with a terminal illness who wish to visit their memorials. To assist disabled veterans, we provide oxygen and wheelchairs.

Please note: Veterans are selected for the flight on a first-come, first-served basis. Veterans who served during the Korean War and the Vietnam War may also apply for the Honor Flight.
