



# 2019 Warbird Rendezvous at CWA

Saturday, July 20, 2019 from 8:00am-4:00pm

## The Mission

Host a warbird fly-in at CWA to honor the veterans of Central Wisconsin and promote aviation to future generations of aviators.

## Goal for 2019

Attract 20-40 aircraft, accommodate up to 5,000 attendees, and send at least 60 veterans on a Never Forgotten Honor Flight.

## Past Success

In **2018**, the event brought 11 warbird aircraft and 2 military fly-overs to CWA. The event attracted over 1,000 attendees, and sent 22 veterans on a Never Forgotten Honor Flight.

In **2017**, the event had zero aircraft due to weather, but attracted over 250 attendees, and sent 6 veterans on a Never Forgotten Honor Flight.

*Both of these past events were held on a Wednesday morning during EAA's AirVenture.*

## Active Military Participation Welcome

We are seeking a variety of military aircraft to participate in this event. The following military activities are welcome:

- Static aircraft displays - either open to public walk-through or secured for viewing only.
- Fly-overs are welcome, but demonstrations are not allowed. This event is a fly-in, not an air show. There will not be an air show box.
- Recruiters are welcome during the event and may setup a booth. Please contact Assistant Airport Director Mark Cihlar ([mcihlar@fly-cwa.org](mailto:mcihlar@fly-cwa.org)) for coordination.
- Other non-aviation military static displays (i.e. howitzer, M-ATV, MRAP, etc.) are also welcome.
- Other considerations:
