My husband, Robert M. Pliska, and our son, Scott R. Pliska, were fortunate in October, 2018 to be on the Honor Flight. For both of them it was truly the most awe inspiring and emotional time they could have ever imagined. It was a dream come true. My husband was in the Army and a proud Vietnam veteran, having been in the service from Feb. 1967 till Feb. 1970. Our son never served in the military.

Several weeks ago, on July 9, my husband's journey on earth came to an end. He had NASH (non-alcoholic liver disease), further complicated by other health issues. In mid-April we put him under Hospice care and then at the end of April he suffered a stroke that left him pretty much bedridden. Fortunately for our children and myself, with the continuing care of Hospice, we were honored to be able to care for him until his death. He truly was the most patient patient ever, even until he took his last breath that morning.
