
I know some people directly donated because the link was stated in his obituary. If possible, could I please get a copy of those names and I can also send a thank you note from the family.

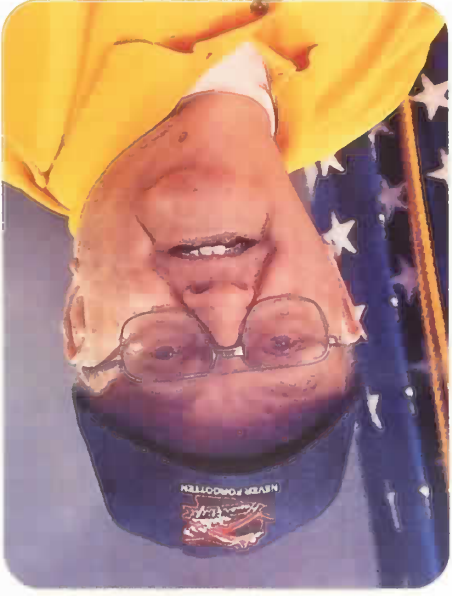
