

Special Health Protocols
v. 2022, effective 2/19/22

We continue to prioritize the safety of all of our veterans and encourage Hubs to stay up to date with CDC, state and local policies including those applicable to high-risk persons. In a rapidly changing environment, HFN yields to federal, state and local guidelines including the policies of our transportation partners (airlines, buses, etc.). HFN reserves the right to update or modify these protocols at any time as needed for the health and safety of our veterans.

COVID Vaccination/Testing

Beginning in 2022, HFN will not require proof of vaccination or negative COVID test for participation in an Honor Flight trip. Hubs may, at their discretion, choose to require that all participants be vaccinated and/or provide proof of a negative COVID test.

HFN will no longer be financially supporting the CLEAR Health Pass in 2022. Hubs that wish to continue using CLEAR Health Pass can contact Meredith for a connection with the CLEAR staff.

Masks

Masks must be worn as required by federal or local policy/ordinance. Additionally, masks must be worn in any venue or business that requires a mask. It continues to be strongly recommended that unvaccinated individuals be encouraged to wear a mask, especially in close settings, while on an Honor Flight trip.

Gatherings

HFN will not have any specific guidelines regarding gatherings or events - such as send offs or welcome homes. Hubs are encouraged to research any state or local guidelines as to large gatherings and ensure that your Hub is in compliance with any such guidelines.
