My Uncle Anthony Brzezinski was born in 1927, on a family dairy farm in the Town of Bevent in Marathon County, Wisconsin; the fourth of 14 children born to Barney and Matilda Brzezinski, first-generation Polish Americans.

He was a proud Korean War Veteran having served for 18 months in the US Army 724h Railroad Battalion. In May 13, 2013, Uncle Anthony was on Flight #12; a day he spoke of often with fond memories.

In 1959 through diligent savings working as a crane operator at American Motors, Anthony invested in his first property, a rooming house on Booth Street in Milwaukee. In the ensuing decades, Uncle Anthony acquired more residential and commercial properties eventually growing his real estate portfolio to over 600 units at his passing in May 2023.

In 2004, Uncle Anthony created a charitable foundation to support Catholic parishes, inspire future entrepreneurs, and support the local community. One of Anthony's fervent hopes was that his story would inspire others to follow his footsteps by working hard to save, invest, and give back to the community.
